



Vessel Productivity

- Greenwich Terminals LLC, operators of the PAMT, consistently achieve over 35 moves per hour! In August 2010, one vessel broke the 50 move per hour mark
- Greenwich Terminals employs 9 house gangs which means that you will always have the same great highly productive labor working your vessels

- Low Congestion makes for high levels of customer satisfaction







In the middle of it all


- The Packer Avenue Marine Terminal sits in the middle of the arterial highways on the North East part of the US

Why Philadelphia?

Dredging the Delaware River to 45ft

- The main ship channel of the Delaware River will be deepened from its existing 40 feet (12.2 meters) to 45 feet (13.7 meters) between a distance of 68 miles (109.4 kilometers)
- Completion will be in line with Panama Canal deepening
- Allows the largest ships to call the Port of Philadelphia.
- Funding Included in the Presidents Federal Budget

"RIVERSIDE RENEWABLE ENERGY SOLAR PROJECT"



Project Details:

- 27,528 Solar panels
- ② Covers over 1.1 million square feet or 103,000 square meters of roof top
- Will Create 9 mega watts of power each year
- it is the LARGEST roof top solar array in North America

Environmental Benefits:

- Eliminating 16 million pounds of CO2 a year
- Removing 1,200 cars from the road
- Planting 400,000 trees

The Gloucester Marine Terminal

Largest On-Dock Refrigerated Warehouse in the United States

Gloucester Terminals

- Gloucester Terminals is located directly across the river from the Packer Avenue Marine Terminal
- Largest on-dock warehouse in the country with over 20 million Cubic Feet of Refrigerated Space
- Gloucester Terminals is home to 4 out of the 5 largest importers of deciduous fruits in the Country
- It is the largest distribution point for Spanish and South African Citrus in the US.
- Del Monte & Walmart both use Gloucester Terminals as their North East Distribution Center
 - Gloucester Terminals services 48 Walmart superstores around the country & is listed as a Walmart distribution center in their system!
- It has 200,000 square feet of Dry food grade space for specialized paper or food products. It also has about 600,000 sq ft. of dry space for other cargoes including steel, plywood, and lumber products
